

Licensing Regulatory Sub-Committee (Taxis)

Procedure at Application Hearing

- 1. Chairman introduces himself.
- 2. Members and Officers introduce themselves.
- 3. The Environmental Health Manager Commercial or the Senior Licensing Officer (the presenting officer) introduces applicant and/or representative.
- 4. The presenting officer provides an introduction/summary of the report.
- 5. Members offered opportunity to question the presenting officer on content of report.
- 6. The applicant /representative present applicant's case.
- 7. Members can question the applicant
- 8. The applicant/representative is given opportunity to sum up
- 9. Members can ask questions for CLARITY ONLY
- 10. Members will deliberate usually in private usually with council's legal representative present.
- 11. Verbal decision given with full written decision with reasons sent within 5 working days.

Details of any rights of appeal will be included.
