Record of Decision: Brighton Marina to River Adur Flood and Coastal Erosion Risk Management Strategy

Decision taken by: Cabinet Member for Health & Wellbeing

Declaration of Disclosable Pecuniary Interests: I hereby confirm that I do not have any disclosable pecuniary interest in this item.

Decision: That further consultation be carried out by officers on the preferred management options for coastal defences on the three identified sections.

Area 1 options considered should be 2.7 sub sections 4 and 5

Area 2 options considered should be sub sections 6 and 8

Area 3 option to be considered should be option 4

Further consultation on the preferred options should be reported back to enable final decisions to be made and agreed for the defence of these sections of the coast.

Finally, to ensure this Coastal Erosion Risk Management Strategy is co-ordinated with those being developed to the West of the identified areas both within Adur and Worthing and beyond to produce a joined up strategic approach to the wider needs of the communities in West Sussex.

Key Decision: Yes / No

Reasons for the Decision: The identified options will give the best chance to retain the local infrastructure, businesses and residential areas in the longer term, and enable forward planning to address future risks of coastal erosion, rising sea levels and changing climatic conditions.

Alternative Options Considered: All other options contained in the strategy have been considered and rejected as having too great a negative risk to the local community and infrastructure or as being too expensive for full implementation.
