Record of Decision: Adur Competitive Community Grants Budget 2015/16 – Round 3

Decision taken by: Executive Member for Health & Wellbeing

Declaration of Disclosable Pecuniary Interests: I hereby confirm that I do not have any disclosable pecuniary interest in this item.

Decision:

The Adur Executive Member for Health & Wellbeing has made his decision concerning the allocation of the 2015/16 Adur Community Grants budget in line with the suggested scoring criteria as follows:-

1. Age UK West Sussex – Chair Exercise Classes for over 65s

Funding of £2,700 was agreed towards the total cost of the project.

2. Community Stand Up Paddle boarding (SUP) Club

Not supported.

3. Company Paradiso – The Rally Project

Funding of £5,000 agreed subject to clarification and agreement in relation to some issues.

4. Hove & Adur Sea Cadets

Funding of £2,000 agreed subject to clarification and agreement in relation to some issues.

5. Independent Lives – Voice for Disability

Funding of £500 agreed subject to agreement in relation to some issues.

6. Ropetackle Arts Centre – Join the Parade – 14 Wards connected in 1 day

Not supported

7. Skyway Gallery

Funding of £3,751 agreed subject to clarification and agreement in relation to some issues.

8. Southwick Cricket Club

Sum agreed £5,000

Additional funding of £13,000 has been agreed to support activities within the Fishersgate area in relation to community development, local organisations and a broader road safety initiative involving our partners in the Fire & Rescue Service to reduce the risk of killed and seriously injured cyclists in the Adur District.

A further £4,000 has been agreed to support a young person's mental health project as part of the Health & Wellbeing Partnership.

Key Decision: Yes / No

Reasons for the Decision: Address local council priorities and provide meaningful support to locally based community organisations providing essential services for the community of the Adur District.

Alternative Options Considered:

In the case of the community cricket nets, this was considered as something that could be supported through the S106 money from the Brighton and Hove Albion Academy development. It was subsequently agreed to provide funds from both sources in order to complete the development.


