IRRECOVERABLE DEBTS - SUNDRY DEBTORS ACCOUNTS

REPORT BY THE DIRECTOR FOR DIGITAL AND RESOURCES

1.0 SUMMARY

- 1.1. This report details outstanding housing rents, which have been the subject of lengthy recovery action and enquiries. The associated debts are now deemed to be irrecoverable and are therefore recommended for write-off.
- 1.2 This is the first report detailing individual debts of over £2,500 to be written off in this financial year.

2.0 BACKGROUND

- 2.1 Paragraph 8.4 of the Council's Financial Regulations require that irrecoverable debts of Sundry Debtors, Commercial Rents and Homeless Accounts and Housing Rents over £2,500 are to be submitted to the Cabinet Member for Resources for write-off.
- 2.2 All outstanding arrears are regularly reviewed and an assessment made as to the likelihood of recovery. The scale of the effort made to collect each debt varies in proportion to the amount outstanding.
- 2.3 Any debt that is written off may subsequently be recovered due to various reasons including a dividend being received in an insolvency case or a debtor being traced.

3.0 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

A. Sundry Debts

3.A.1 Irrecoverable debts totalling £17,073.66 covering 5 accounts are submitted for write-off within this report
