#### **Decision:**

The Executive Member has agreed that, in line with Core Strategy Policy 10 and subject to viability considerations, the Council should continue to seek 10% affordable housing (sought via a financial contribution) on sites of 6-10 dwellings.

The Executive Member has noted that further viability assessments will be undertaken to demonstrate that smaller brownfield sites would not be affected by seeking affordable housing contributions, particularly having regard to the application of the vacant building credit.
