JGC/16-17/005 Appointment of Independent Persons for Standards Purposes

Before the Committee was an exempt information report by the Director for Communities and the Director for Digital and Resources, copies of which had been circulated to all Members.

The report requested that the sub-committee consider applications for the role of Independent Persons for the purposes of Standards and make recommendations to Council in regards to the appointments.

It was noted that the Councils were statutorily obliged to appoint at least one Independent Person, and that such persons would be co-opted non-voting Members of the Joint Governance Committee.

Resolved,

That the Joint Governance Sub-Committee:-

- 6.1 interviewed the candidates and recommended to both Adur District Council and Worthing Borough Council the appointment of three Independent Persons, namely, Susan Clark, John Todd and Simon Norris-Jones;
- 6.2 recommended to Adur District Council and Worthing Borough Council that the Independent Persons be appointed for a term of four years and for a maximum of 2 terms only (8 years), subject to the Full Councils being able to de-select an Independent Person on reasonable grounds;
- 6.3 agreed that the Monitoring Officer carry out an informal review with each Independent Person at the end of the first year, to assess whether or not they are willing to continue in the role.
