This decision needs to be taken and agreed by the 12th September 2017 if these funds are to be available for this purpose. If delayed the Council will be unable to bid for this property. Therefore the usual process to make a decision under regulation 9 is deemed impracticable as it would undermine the Councils' stated aims of increasing the availability of temporary accommodation."
