<b>Reason for Decision:</b> WBC Executive Member for Regeneration - Worthing Pier is a Grade II unique structure and forms part of the heritage of the town acting as a destination in terms of recreation and visitor economy. WBC has an obligation to act as guardian to our heritage on behalf of the people of Worthing. The measures proposed are therefore necessary to protect and secure the future of the pier as well as users of this structure.
