**LCCA/14-15/03    Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982 – Schedule 4  
Changes to Street Trading Controls**

Before the Committee was a report by the Director of Communities, copies of which had been distributed to all Members and a copy of which is attached to the signed copy of these minutes as item 3. Members were requested to consider changing the designation under the above act of two streets in the town centre that are currently designated 'prohibited' streets for street trading purposes. The report sought to change their designation to that of 'consent' street so allowing the provision of occasional street markets, subject to the required permissions.

The Senior Licensing Officer clarified some points regarding the process for the management of a proposed market. Members were told that the Director for communities would make decisions on an application for a market in the south end of Portland road and could refer the issue back to the Committee should there be any concerns.

**Resolved:** that Bath Place and Portland Road (From the junction of Shelly Road to Montague Street) be re-designated as consent streets for the purposes of street trading in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982, and that such resolution to come into effect on 27 July 2014.

The meeting was declared closed by the Chairman at 6.12pm, it having commenced at 6pm.
