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#### Executive Summary

##### 1. Purpose

- 1.1. Before the beginning of this Municipal Year, the Council approved a schedule of meetings for the following year in order to help plan the Council's business.
- 1.2. Should a change to a date of a Council meeting be required it is behove of Council to approve that change.
- 1.3. The recent General Election has caused a delay to the LGA conference originally scheduled for the first week of July. The new dates for the conference clash with the October Council meeting and a request has been forward for a change of date in order to foster Council Leadership representation at that conference.

##### 2. Recommendations

- 2.1. The Council is recommended to approve a change to the date of the Worthing Borough Council meeting from Tuesday 22 October 2024 to Tuesday 15 October 2024.

### **3. Context**

- 3.1. In order to enable the efficient administration of the Council's business and the delivery of Council services, there needs to be planned activities that cover the period of the 2024/25 Municipal Year.
- 3.2. The schedule of meetings advises both Members and Officers on when to carry out Council activities and to that end, enhances the decision making process.
