Declaration of Disclosable Pecuniary Interests: I hereby confirm that I do not have any disclosable pecuniary interest in this item.

Decision:

The Executive Member for Regeneration has agreed to release £40,000 towards the provision of the recently completed footpath and agreed that this is added to the capital programme for 2020/21.

Key Decision: No

Reason For Decision:

The provision of sustainable transport, whether cycling or walking forms part of various strategies adopted by this council. I note the concerns raised by the officer in the report about this being for a path, rather than the planned dual walking and cycling route. This is disappointing and represents a missed opportunity. Nonetheless the provision of this route is still important linking key modal points within the West Durrington to Goring conurbation.

Alternative Options Considered:

- 1. not to support this request option dismissed
- not to support this request and send it back for revision option dismissed on grounds that the report has identified that the path construction does lend itself to future conversion and causing greater delay would disadvantage the local community.
