<b>Record of Decision:</b> W/REG/007/20-21 Release of s106 Funds to help deliver new footpath parallel to Titnore Lane			
<b>Decision taken by:</b> Worthing Executive Member for Regeneration			
<b>Declaration of Disclosable Pecuniary Interests:</b> I hereby confirm that I do not have any disclosable pecuniary interest in this item.			
<b>Decision:</b> The Executive Member for Regeneration has agreed to release £40,000 towards the provision of the recently completed footpath and agreed that this is added to the capital programme for 2020/21.			
<b>Key Decision:</b> No			
<b>Reason For Decision:</b> The provision of sustainable transport, whether cycling or walking forms part of various strategies adopted by this council. I note the concerns raised by the officer in the report about this being for a path, rather than the planned dual walking and cycling route. This is disappointing and represents a missed opportunity. Nonetheless the provision of this route is still important linking key modal points within the West Durrington to Goring conurbation.			
<b>Alternative Options Considered:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>not to support this request - option dismissed</li> <li>not to support this request and send it back for revision - option dismissed on grounds that the report has identified that the path construction does lend itself to future conversion and causing greater delay would disadvantage the local community.</li> </ol>
