Reasons for decision

The reasons given for the decision are that the committee members are extremely concerned that there have been 17 incidents within the last 6 years that the driver has held a hackney driving licence including vehicle safety, motoring offences, non-compliance with Worthing Borough Council hackney and private hire driving conditions and customer complaints. This behaviour is not acceptable from a professional driver who is in a position of trust. Should any further incidents occur officers will be expected to
