It is my view that the southern part of the ward is poorly served with polling station access. Additionally the current polling station has terrible parking access and the road is regularly clogged.</p> <p>When you look at the current location's on a map there is a significant lack of polling station access in the more coastal part of Marine ward, and to some extent Goring ward. Other wards have a more centrally placed polling station. I would suggest that Marine and Goring would benefit from an additional polling station at St Laurence's church in Sea Place. This could be shared and would add an easily accessible place for those living far away from Elm Grove. I would be interested to see voting turnout plotted on a map to see whether there is a correlation between proximity to polling stations and propensity to vote. If there were to be a demonstrable link, I would suggest that the local authority has a duty to place polling stations in locations that have lower turnout.</p> <p>Many thanks comment received via email 12/10/23</p> <p>—</p> <p>I believe the most appropriate station I have experienced is the church on the corner of Ripley Road.
