Register of Member's Interests

1.0 You must register your interests

- 1.1 Within 28 days of your Election or appointment to Office, you must notify the Council's Monitoring Officer, Susan Sale, of your 'Disclosable Pecuniary Interests'. A 'Disclosable Pecuniary Interest' is an interest of a Member or their partner (spouse, civil partner, cohabitee) within the description set out in the form. The declaration is to be made on this Register of Member's Interests Form. This is a requirement of the Localism Act 2011 and the Worthing Borough Council Code of Conduct.

It is your duty and responsibility to declare your Disclosable Pecuniary Interests and failure to do so, within 28 days or at all, to give false or misleading information, or to omit relevant information, may constitute a criminal offence under the Localism Act 2011.

- 1.2 Within 28 days of your Election or appointment to Office, you must further notify the Council's Monitoring Officer, Susan Sale, of your 'Personal and Pecuniary Interests'. A 'Personal and Pecuniary Interest' is an interest of a Member or a relevant person (to include their family and any person with whom they have a close association) which falls within the descriptions set out in this form. The declaration is to be made on this Register of Member's Interests Form. This is a requirement of the Worthing Borough Council Code of Conduct for Members, and failure to declare such interests may render the Member in breach of the Code.
- 1.3 If you have become a Member or Co-opted Member of the Council as a result of re-election or re-appointment, then paragraphs 1.1 and 1.2 apply only as regards Interests not entered in the Council's Register when the notification is given.
- 1.4 Please make your declarations by completing all the sections of the attached form, signing, dating and returning it, as soon as possible, but in any event by **Friday 1st June 2018** to Chris Cadman-Dando, on behalf of The Monitoring Officer, Worthing Borough Council, Town Hall, Chapel Road, Worthing, West Sussex, BN11 1HA. If there is insufficient space at any particular category on the form, please supply the details on an additional sheet.
- 1.5 As much of the work of Worthing Borough Council is conducted in partnership with Adur District Council, you may, during your term of Office, be involved in meetings, decisions or discussions in relation to Joint Working, and therefore your declaration should cover interests you may have within the boundaries of the District of Adur and the Borough of Worthing.

2.0 You must keep the information up to date

2.1 You are also required to maintain your Register of Interests and ensure it is up to date, complete and accurate at all times. If you become aware of any amendments affecting your Register you must notify the Monitoring Officer, in writing, as soon as possible, and at least within 28 days of the change becoming effective. In order to assist you in keeping your Register up to date, you will receive a reminder each May with a request to confirm your details remain correct or to amend them accordingly.

3.0 Publication of Information

3.1 Your Register of Interests will be available for public inspection and will be published on the Council's website, subject to paragraph 3.2 below.

3.2 Under Section 32 of the Localism Act 2011, where a Member or Co-opted Member has an interest and the nature of the interest is such that the Member or Co-opted Member and the Council's Monitoring Officer consider that disclosure of the details of the interest could lead to the Member or Co-opted Member, or a person connected with the Member or Co-opted Member, being subject to violence or intimidation, the interest will be entered in the Council's Register of Interests, but copies of the Register that are made available for inspection, and any published version of the Register, will not include details of that interest (but may state that the Member or Co-opted Member has an interest the details of which are withheld under this sub-section).

4.0 Advice and Assistance

4.1 Further reference should be made to the Worthing Borough Council Code of Conduct in part 5 of the Council's Constitution which can be found on the Council's website, and to sections 26-37 Localism Act 2011.


